Indian Micro, Small and Medium Enterprise (MSME) Sector: size and importance

26 million MSME units providing employment to about59 million people

6000 products – traditional to high-tech; accounts for 45% of manufacturing output


40% of India's total exports comes from MSMEs

## Energy Intensity in MSME Sector

- While MSME sector play a critical role in Indian economy, they are also energy intensive and dispersed in clusters.
- A TERI review shows that of 393 manufacturing (industry) clusters, at least 178 clusters are energy-intensive and have potential for high or medium level of energy savings
- Review also revealed that:
  - Many energy-intensive small-scale sectors do **not** figure among the identified clusters—a typical example being the brick industry.
  - Knowledge gap on energy consumption patterns in the Indian small-scale industry


# SDC's Engagement in MSME Sector: an example of energy conservation in MSME

Established a **Knowledge sharing platform** – **SAMEEEKSHA** – Small And Medium Enterprises: Energy Efficiency Knowledge Sharing



### TERI-SDC Partnership (1994-2008)

- baseline study and sub sector indentification
- action research for technology development & demonstration
- fine tuning & demo units, pilot replications & integration of social action in technology interventions
- CoSMile: Competence network for Small & Micro Learning Enterprises





# Lessons from Teri-SDC Partnership (TSP) for up-scaling

- Present status of replications:
  - Number of replications: about 600 units
  - Estimated energy savings: 140,000 tonnes of oil equivalent
  - Approx. 500,000 tonnes of CO<sub>2</sub> reductions

#### Scaling-up would require:

- Support to R&D efforts: Critical for accelerating the adoption of energy efficient technologies and practices
- Strengthening of existing national institutions as technology nodes: Preferred route for accelerated diffusion and transfer of technologies in the SME sector deriving from CoSMiLE's model for technology development and diffusion

## SDC's Global Programme on Climate Change

- A global initiative for a global issue focuses primarily on China, India, South Africa and the Andean region
- Mitigation Avoid the unmanageable
  - Reduction of greenhouse gases by supporting lowcarbon development pathways – clean energy, energy efficiency and reduction of deforestation
- Adaptation Manage the unavoidable
  - Climate-resilient development focusing on sustainable management of soil, water sources and forests; and disaster risk reduction
- A global deal for a global issue
  - Policy dialogue on climate with focus on multilateral and national levels




# **Indo-Swiss Cooperation in Climate Change in India**

  - South South and South North South Exchange




#### Global Programme on Climate Change India 2011
