



Project Progress













Component 1: Increased capacity of suppliers of EE/RE product suppliers/ service providers/ finance providers

- 250 units were surveyed in 9 clusters
- 54 energy audits have been completed
- 20 big investment projects and 350 small scale projects are implemented
- 150 Case studies prepared
- 6 Dissemination workshops at Coimbatore, Belgaum, Indore, Thangadh, Jamnagar and Gandhinagar were carried out.

Output 1.1 **EE/RE** technologies that are adjusted for local needs.

Output 1.2. Increased ability of **Local Service Providers**

- 27 workshops on Best Operating Practices and common monitorable parameters held
 - 80 DPRs were prepared (25 implemented and 20 are under implementation)
- Developed list of LSPs in 9 clusters
- Capacity building LSPs is under way

Qutput 1.4 anced financing EE/RE projects.

- Activity plan is prepared
- ToR under development to appointing an agency to carryout the various activities.

Output 1.3 Establishment of "Cluster level management cells"

- 9 EMC were established and officially inaugurated during National Summit on EE for MSMS during 31st October
- Three more EMC will be stablished within next 6th months

















Component 2:Increasing the level of end-use demand and implementation of EE and RE technologies and practices by MSMEs

Output 2.1 Increased demand for EE/RE products/services and increased ability to apply for financing among the MSME units for EE & RE Projects.

- 4 demo projects implemented at Belgaum, Coimbatore, Indore and Gujarat clusters
- 3 demo projects are under implementation at Coimbatore, and Jalandhar and 42 projects are under evaluation
- More than 380 projects are implemented by SME units with the help of cluster leaders
- More than 10060 (28W) EE ceiling fans were installed at Thangadh
- 1 National Level Conference

Output 2.2 An increase in the awareness and implementation of Best Operating Procedures for energy management in MSMEs.

- Best operating practices (BOP) developed and shared
- 27 awareness cum training workshops were held to disseminate the BOPs and CMPs
- BOP and CMP booklets and posters are publishing and shared among the MSME units

Output 3.1 Cooperation and synergies established and enhanced within the project clusters.

- Expert consultant will be hired to develop strategies and policies.









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Innovative Projects – Demand Aggregation for 28W EE **Ceiling Fans**

Thangadh Ceramic Cluster

- ➤ Project facilitated implementation of 28W EE ceiling fans
- More than 10060 EE fans installed in the cluster
- ➤ Electricity savings of 30 lakh units and 2454 tonnes of GHG emission per year
- ➤ Discussions are in final stage to implement the another 10000 EE fans

Jalandhar Hand tool Cluster

- Around 300 EE fans are currently installed in the cluster
- ➤ Discussions are in final stage to implement 1000 EE fans

65 % savings in electricity

Unit Location: Coimbatore


Equipment: 150 Amps – Active Harmonic Filter and 100 kVAr Detuned Filter

Investment: 8.0 Lakhs

Payback period: 19 Months

Project Name: Insert the Graphite Bar into the furnace to cool the furnace crucible by absorbing the heat & thus avoid the operation of cooling tower for additional hours

Unit Location: Indore

Modification: Graphite Bar

Investment: 0.12 lakhs

Payback period: 2 months

Benefits:

Energy Savings – 11250 kWh/year

Monitory Benefits – 0.84 lakhs/year














